KEEP IT OUT, THANKS

The following items are not suitable for your yellow lidded recycling bin:

- Paper and cardboard heavily contaminated with food or grease, such as pizza box bases and other take away packaging
- Tissues
- Wax coated or soiled cardboard, such as fruit boxes and wet cardboard
- Soft plastics, including plastic bags, frozen vegetable bags as well as cling wrap.

You can recycle your window envelopes, glossy magazines and even your milk & juice cartons. You don't need to worry about removing those pesky staples or paper clips either! These are removed with screening

equipment when the paper and cardboard is pulped prior to making new paper & cardboard products!



TIPS TO REDUCE PAPER AND CARDBOARD WASTE

- ✓ Think before printing – do as much as you can on-screen, such as reviewing, editing and completing forms
- ✓ Use both sides of every sheet of paper. Set printers to default to double-sided and reuse the reverse side of single printed papers
- ✓ Avoid junk mail by using a 'No Junk Mail' sticker
- ✓ Do not put plastic bags, food waste or polystyrene into your yellow-lidded recycling bin as they may contaminate other recyclable products
